

Confirming your affiliation on a publication to UWA

In the absence of a University byline, you can still confirm your affiliation to UWA if you undertook the research in your capacity as a UWA staff or student.

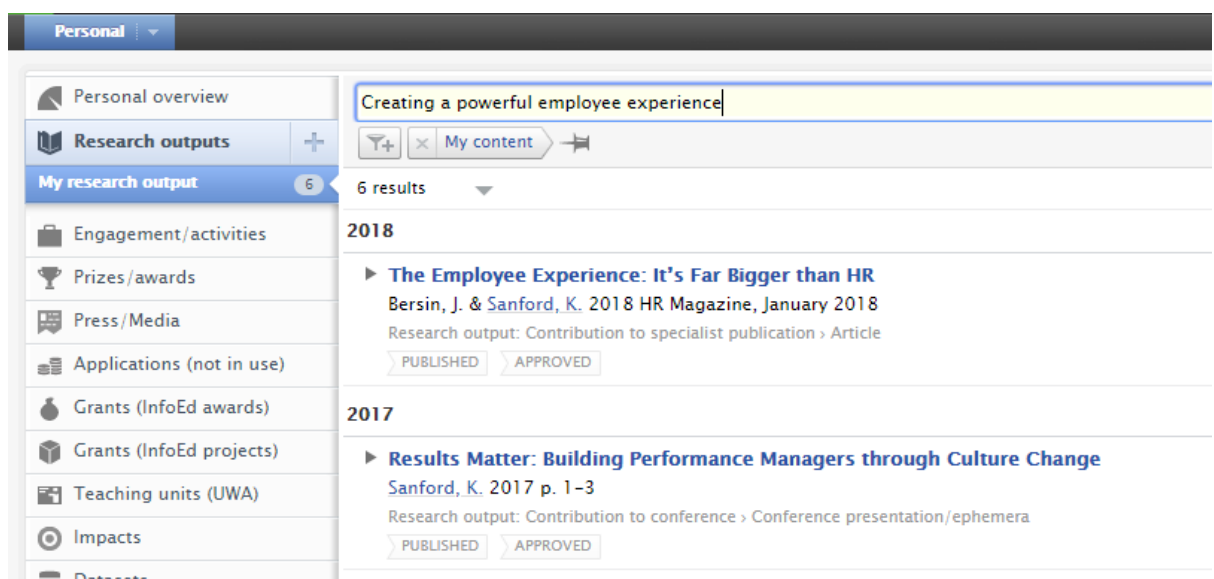
These instructions describe the process of logging into the UWA Profiles and Research Repository and demonstrate how you can confirm your affiliation on a publication to UWA.

Login to start:

1. Go to the [UWA Profiles and Research Repository](#)
2. Click on **Profiles and Research Repository login**
3. Log in with your UWA login (Pheme) details



1. Once logged in, click **Research outputs** from the menu on the left.
2. Locate the research output record you wish to confirm your affiliation to, or enter the publication title in the search box.



3. Open the research output record by clicking on the publication title.
4. Click **History and comments** from the menu on the left.
5. Click **Write a comment about the content** and include the following statement:

"I confirm that I undertook the research leading to this publication in my capacity as a staff member or affiliated associate to the University of Western Australia."
