## Find Articles: Research Databases

Known bug: Subject search browse screens do not display the names of the databases in alphabetical order.

To find articles: Select a database, then search that database for articles. Many databases include full-text (articles you can read from your computer).

### Find a database:

Type the first 3-4 letters of the database name:

FIND

# Bibliographic and Resource Relationship

Do we need a bibliographic record as well as a resource record?

Issues:

- Overlap between bib and resource record
- Accessing resource record
  - Resource name as a separate search option
  - Include the resource name in the title index
- UWA decision: Maintain a bibliographic record for each resource record**

## The UWA Library catalogue

### Search the catalogue by:

- ▶ Title
- ▶ Keywords
- ▶ Author
- ▶ Author & Title
- ▶ Subject heading (Library of Congress, etc.)
- ▶ Call number
- ▶ Standard number (ISBN, ISSN, etc.)
- ▶ System number
- ▶ Barcode

### Find

- ▶ Course materials for your unit
- ▶ Examination papers
- ▶ UWA theses

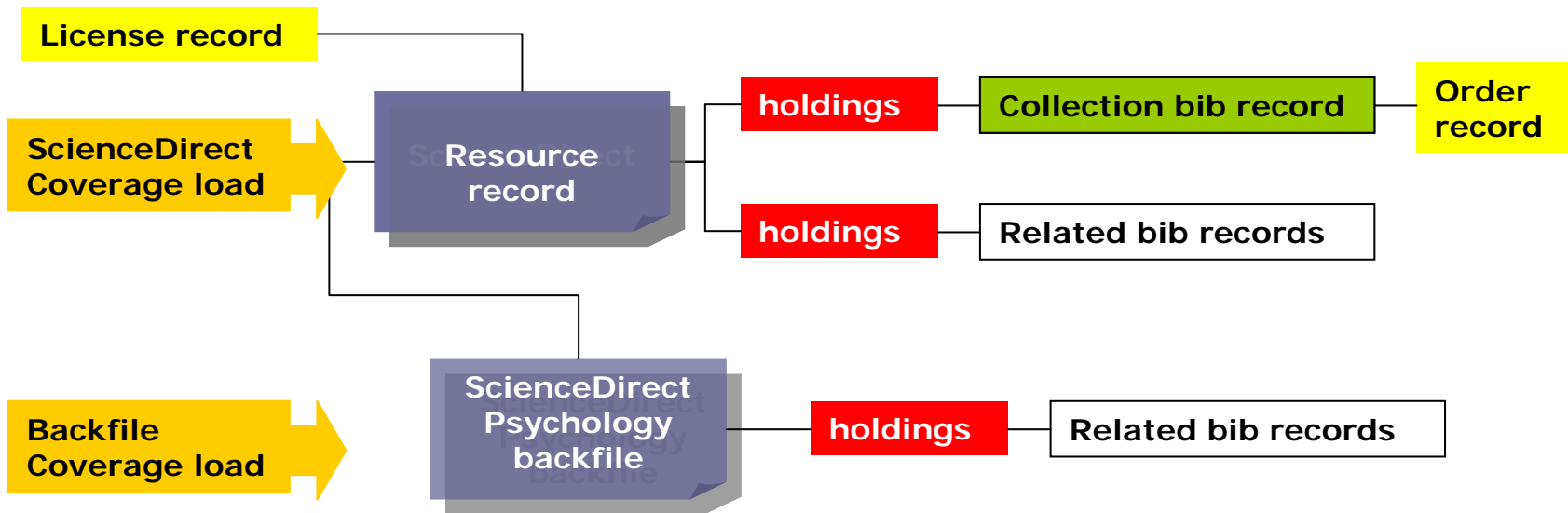

# Capturing the complexity of electronic resources

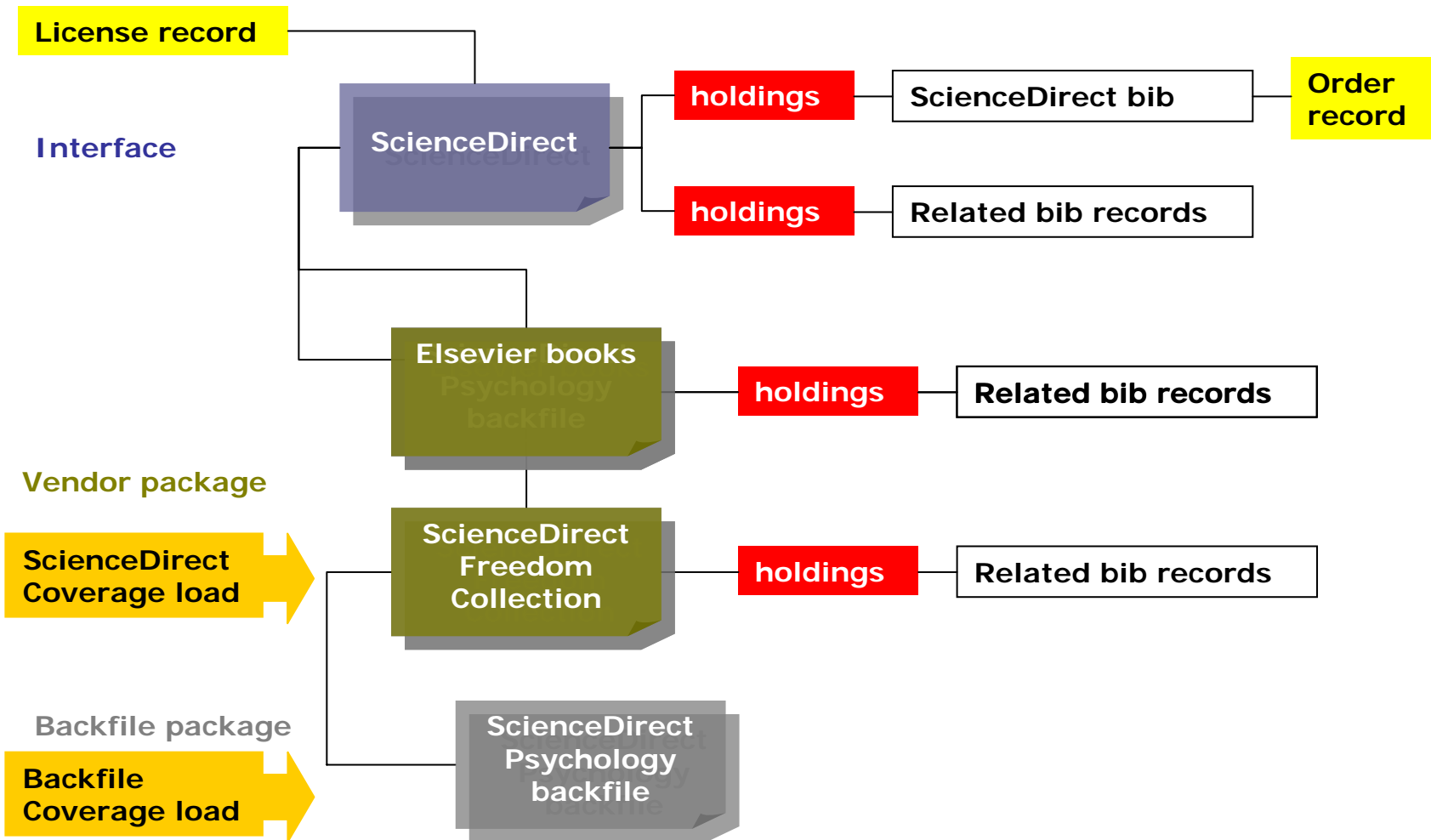
Structure needs to be flexible to:

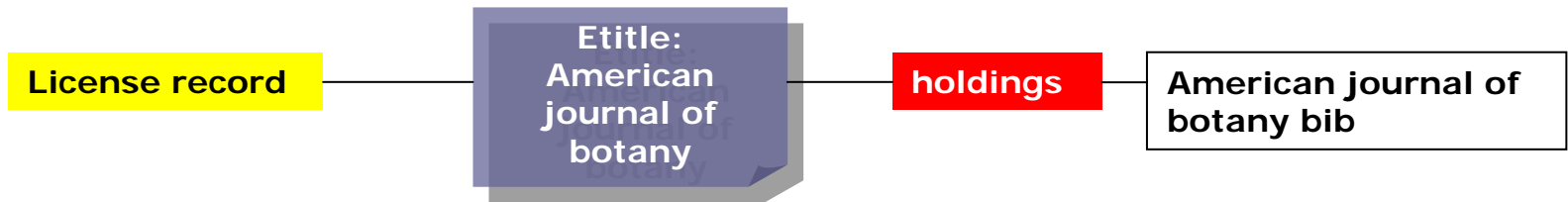


# Resource levels

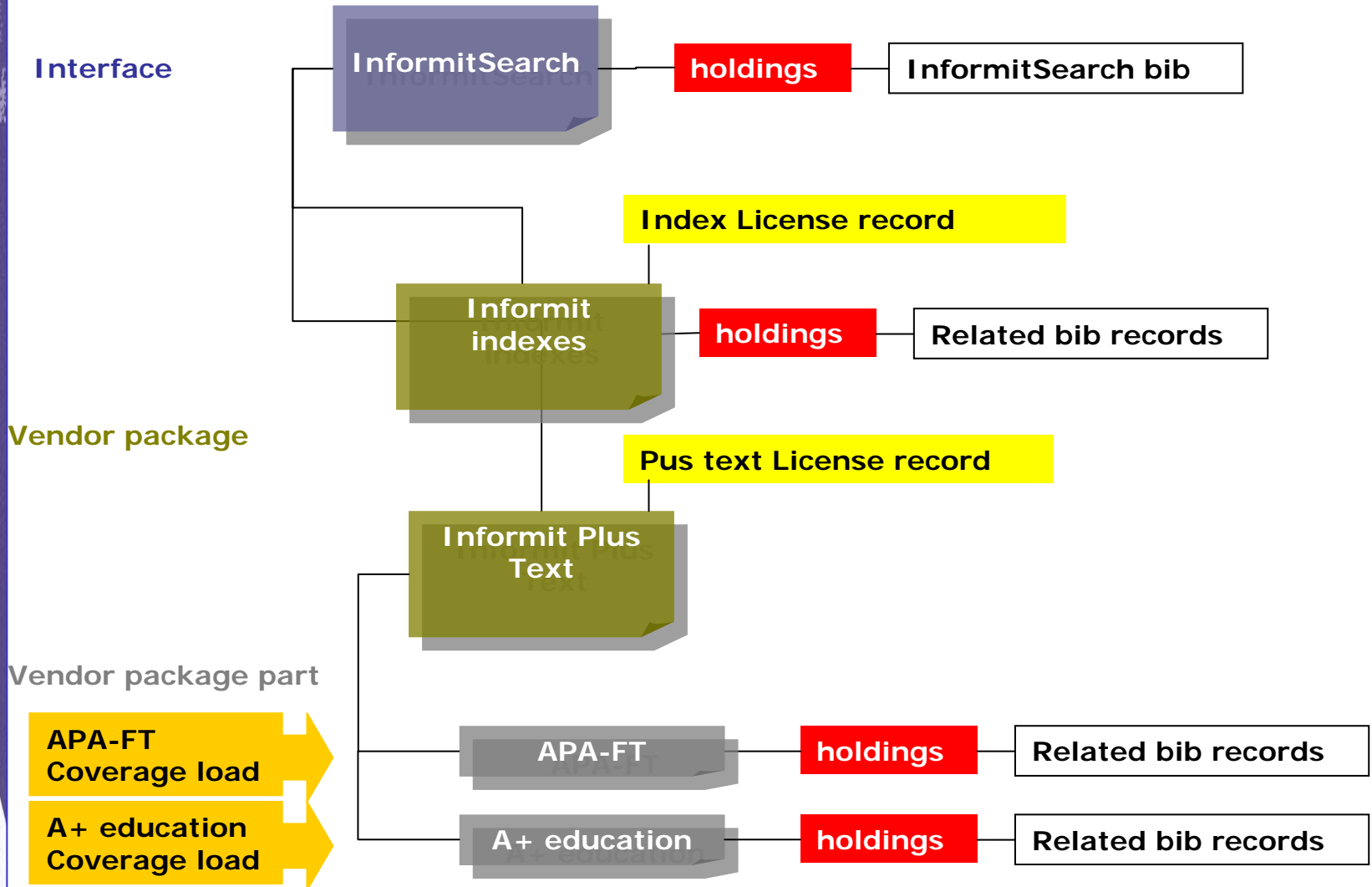
Identified six resource levels:

# Example1: Highwire record structure



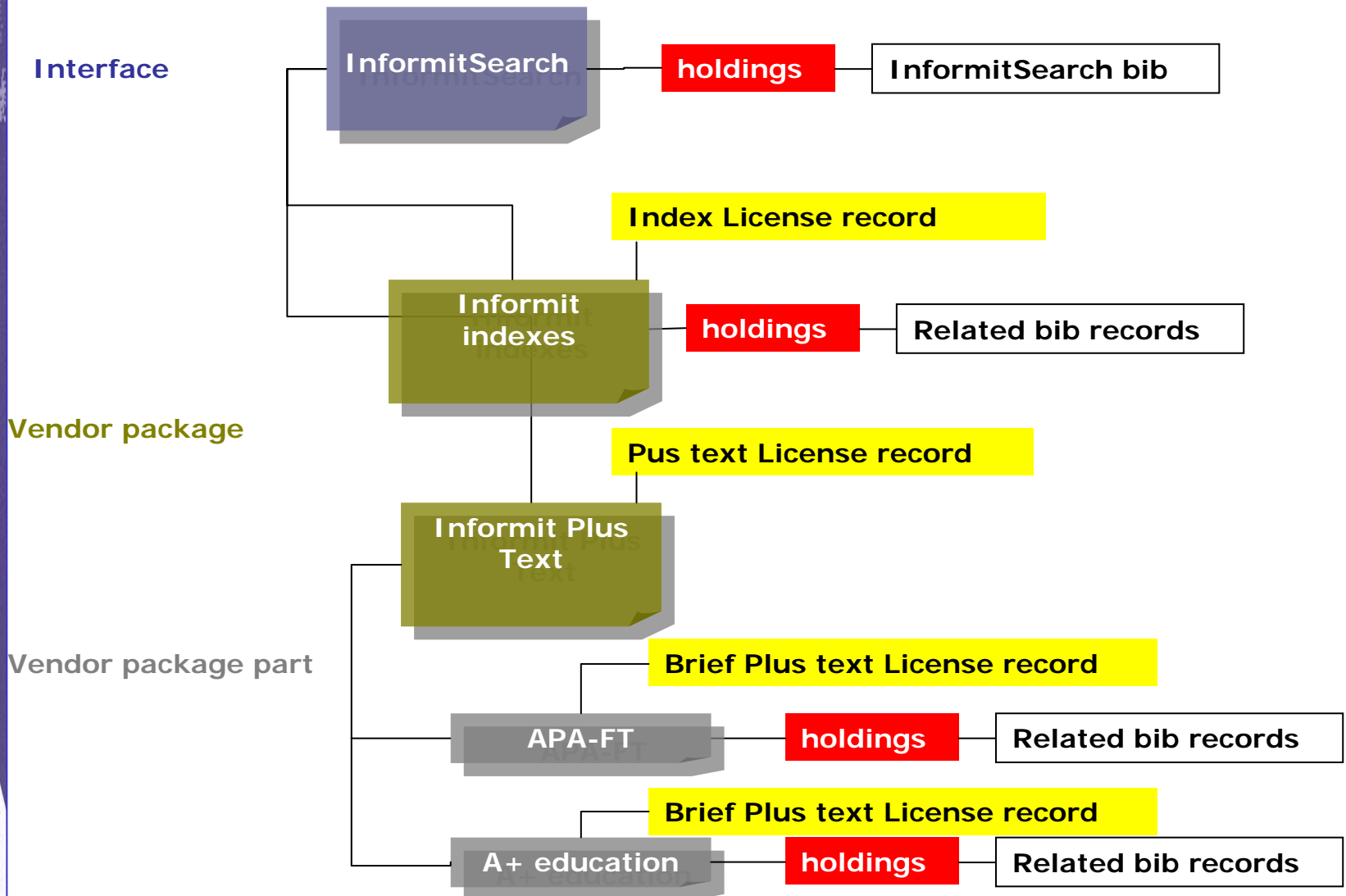

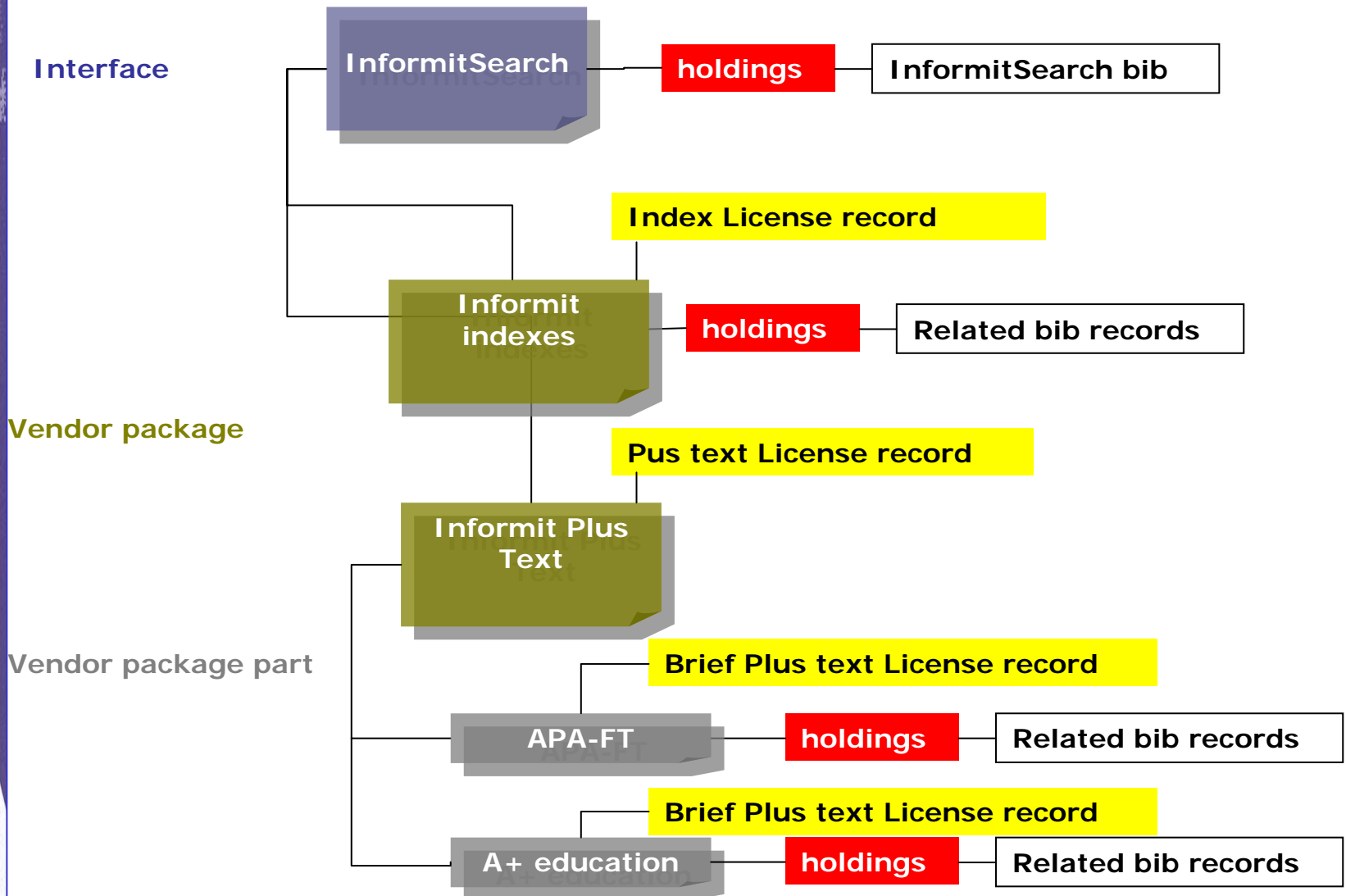
