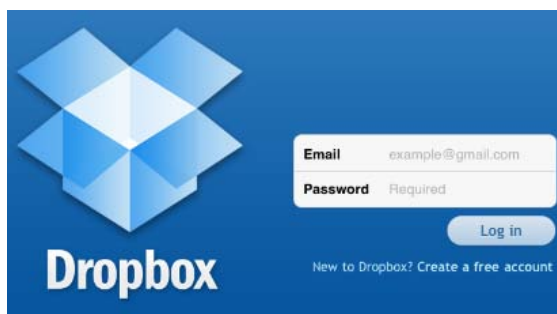
First Step

Enter your Email address and DropBox password. If you do not have a DropBox account, select "Create a free account" and enter the requested details

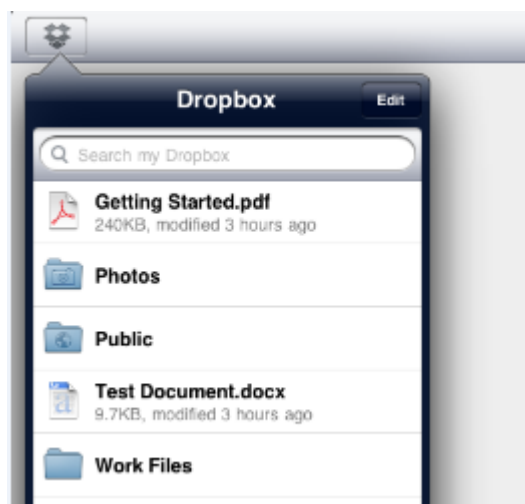


Third Step

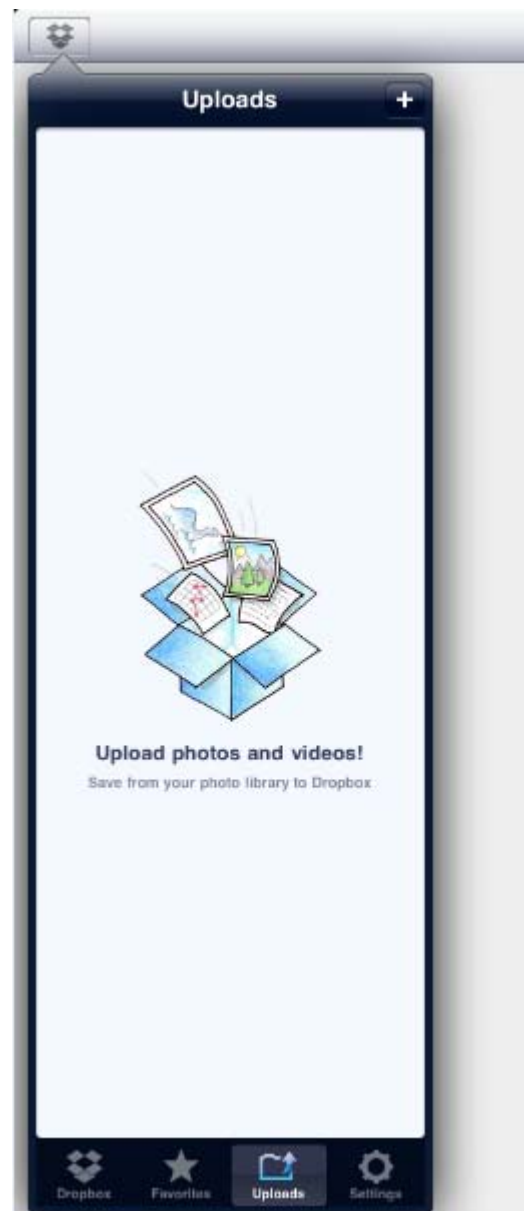

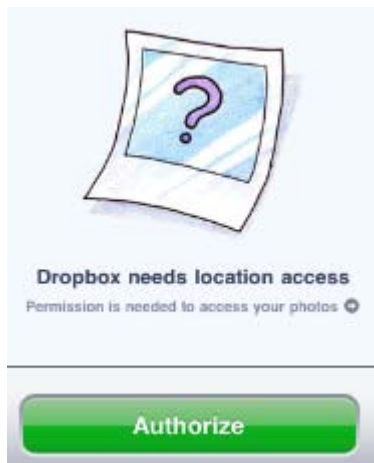

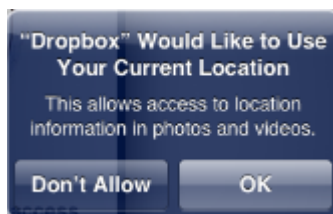
